ASSESSMENT REVIEW BOARD BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF STIRLING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE OF STIRLING TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF RAYMOND FOR ASSESSMENT APPEAL BOARD SERVICES.

WHEREAS THE Village of Stirling is required to have an Assessment Review Board pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act* (R.S.A. 2004, c. M-26 as amended);

AND WHEREAS THE Village of Stirling may enter into an agreement with another Municipality to provide Assessment Appeal Board Services pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act* (R.S.A. 2004, c. M-26 as amended);

AND WHEREAS THE Village of Stirling and the Town of Raymond are both willing to enter into an agreement.

NOW THEREFORE by virtue of the power conferred upon it by the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of Village of Stirling, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1.1 This By-law shall be known and may be cited as the "Assessment Review Board Bylaw" of the Village of Stirling.

2.1 The Council of the Village of Stirling hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Assistant Chief Administrative Officer to execute the approved agreement with the Town of Raymond for Assessment Appeal Board Services.
