Election Bylaw**

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF STIRLING TO OUTLINE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

**WHEREAS**, Section 46 of the Local Authorities Election Act, Revised of Alberta 2000, c. L-21 states that an elected authority may by bylaw passed prior to June 30 in an election year provide that voting stations will open prior to 10 a.m.;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Village of Stirling in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, thereby enacts as follows:

**PART 1 – NAME OF BYLAW**

1. This bylaw may be cited as the Election Bylaw.

**PART 2 – PURPOSE**

2. The purpose of this bylaw is to establish rules for the conduct of Village election in accordance with the requirements of the Local Authorities Election Act.


**PART 3 – PROCEDURE**

3. Voting station hours in the Village of Stirling will be as follows:
  - a. The voting station will be open from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on election day;
4. This bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS THE 15<sup>th</sup> DAY OF February, 2017

READ A SECOND TIME THIS THE 1<sup>st</sup> DAY OF March, 2017

READ A THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS THE 1<sup>st</sup> DAY OF March, 2017
