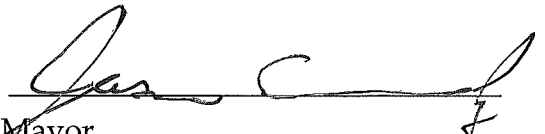
Councillor Hirsche asked administration to contact FORTIS about a flickering street light at the corner of 6A Street.
