CALLED TO ORDER Mayor Edwards called the meeting to order at 7:13 pm.

2012-166 AGENDA Councillor Hirsche moved to adopt the agenda. Carried

DELEGATION(S) Chris Johnson asked Council for information about Shipping Containers at the property on 400 block or 4th Street.

Johnson then made a request to Council to remove the signs advertising the Haunted Mansion from 3 locations within the Village. The signs were posted on power poles and a street sign.

Johnson then read a letter to Council which was addressed to the Village office from Park Enterprises regarding an inspection request Johnson made for the Haunted Mansion property.

Johnson also spoke about the decision issued by the MPC on June 20, 2012 to deny a home occupation application made by Richard Reimer.


2012-167 MINUTES Councillor Bikman moved to adopt the minutes of the October 3, 2012 Council Meeting as amended. Carried


2012-169 Councillor Hirsche moved to accept accounts payable #20120884. Mayor Edwards abstained. Carried
