Dog Control Bylaw Amendment**

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF STIRLING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND
BYLAW NO. 423-08, A BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING AND
CONTROLLING DOGS.**

WHEREAS Sections 7 and 8 of the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, authorize Council of the Village of Stirling to pass bylaws to license and regulate wild and domestic animals and activities in relation to them;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Stirling deems it advisable to adopt such a bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF STIRLING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Dog Control Bylaw No. 423-08, Section 5.1 be amended to read:

5.1 The maximum number of Dogs over the age of six (6) months which can be kept in any single family dwelling or on any lot, parcel or other property in the Village is three (3).

This bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading thereof.
