RIDGE COUNTRY HOUSING

Councillor Lewington reported on the Ridge Country Housing 2017 budget process. He further reviewed the budget and the request from the Ridge Country Housing for a letter of support for financial support for the Prairie Rose Lodge Expansion and Renovation and the Ridgeview Lodge Replacement.

Council discussed the request for the letter of support allowing Ridge Country Housing to borrow up to a maximum of \$600,000 to cover acquisition of capital assets and to cover operational deficits.

Councillor Edwards moved to approve the Village to support for long term borrowing of up to a maximum of \$600,000.00 and for a term not to exceed 10 years to assist with the operating deficit and debt servicing costs resulting form the previous construction project at the Prairie Rose Lodge in Milk River and unfunded operation and capital costs resulting from the construction of the new Ridgeview Lodge in Raymond;

And further direct the Mayor to sign the Letter of Support.
