Councillor Nilsson spoke on behalf of Anne Nelson. He indicated that Anne Nelson said she was not told they would be responsible for the cost of the curb stop replacement and therefore were requesting the invoice be forgiven or reduced.

Administration presented background information on the request from the property owner to turn off the water at the property which triggered the need to replace the curb stop. Information was also presented on the process and policy for dealing with repairs or improvements to be made on water and sewer residential connections. Additional information was presented on the concessions made by the Village and employees at the property and support and assistance given to the property owner.

Councillor Nilsson indicated that he explained to Anne Nelson that the curb stop would have had to be replaced, regardless of when. Councillor Nilsson also spoke with Shane Still, Manager of Operations, and was told that concessions had been made even before presenting Administration with the invoice amount.
