Further move that Council direct Administration to work with Alberta Municipal Affairs and the Alberta Urban Municipalities Association to investigate options related to potential deferrals and adjustments to property taxes and report back to Council as a result of recent announcements by the provincial government related to holding the education portion at the 2019 levels and with the potential for up to 6 month deferrals for commercial properties.
