Regulated Rate Option Prices to Soar in August

Ridge Utilities and other competitive retailers offer lower fixed rates to improve affordability.

Stirling, Alberta - The cost of electricity is set to increase by 16% to 22% for the Regulated Rate Option (RRO) or so-called "default rate" customers in August. These will be the highest actual RRO prices ever charged to customers in Alberta.

"It is important to remind Alberta residents that they have options to manage anticipated higher electricity bills. In particular, many consumers currently struggling with paying their monthly energy bills can minimize their financial stress simply by getting off the government's RRO to a predictable fixed rate plan," noted Scott Donselaar, Ridge Utilities General Manager.

The planned increase in regulated rates published by the Alberta Utilities Commission is dramatic. In August, the rates will increase to an average of 32.267 cents/kWh. Compared to rates offered by small competitive retailers like Ridge Utilities, consumers using roughly 700 kWh per month will pay approximately \$140 extra on the RRO in August.

"Part of the driver for us to create a community-owned energy marketer was to help provide more competitive options for consumers on electricity, natural gas and internet service," added Trevor Lewington, Mayor, Village of Stirling. "Now is the time to ditch the regulated rate and save."
