DA2016-12 SCHOOL MODERNIZATION Planner/Development Officer Bonnie Brunner presented a report on Development Permit application DA2016-12.

Councillor Lewington moved to approve Development Permit Application DA2016-12 with the following conditions and informative:

Conditions:

- 1. The portion of closed road on Plan 8210319 and Lots 9-12, Block 31, Plan 8210319 shall be consolidated with Lot 15 SR, Block 31, Plan 8210319 through a plan of consolidation prepared by an Alberta Land Surveyor and registered with Land Titles.
- 2. The development is to conform to the development permit application dated June 29, 2016, and the approved site plan attached.
- 3. The development, including final site grading shall be completed within 30 months from the date of issuance of this development permit.
- The final building grade shall be completed so drainage flows away from the buildings but so as not to adversely affect the neighbouring lots.

- 5. All refuse on the construction site shall be property screened or placed in an approved enclosure until removed for disposal.
- 6. The applicant is responsible for obtaining a building permit prior to commencement and any other applicable safety codes permits from the designated safety codes officer (e.g., fire, electric, plumbing).
- 7. The applicant shall pay a parking fee in lieu of off-street parking spaces, the value of which will be established by resolution of Council.
- 8. The yards facing 4th Avenue and 3rd Street disturbed by construction shall be re-landscaped upon completion of construction.

Informative:

- 1. The applicant must contact Alberta One Call (1800-242-3447) to locate any utility lines prior to commencement.
- 2. According to the Land Use Bylaw, shipping containers are a "prohibited use;" therefore, they are not allowed to be used as site storage while construction takes place.
