

**VILLAGE OF STIRLING

Bylaw No. 550-24
Amendment to Bylaw No. 530-22 Dog Control Bylaw**

A Bylaw of the Village of Stirling in the Province of Alberta to amend Bylaw 530-22 subsection 4.7 regarding a vicious dog appeal process.

AND WHEREAS section 63(2)(i) of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended permits changes to the bylaw, without changing the substance of the bylaw, to amend subsection 4.7 of Bylaw 530-22 to read:

- 4.7 Conditions shall be set out by Council on how a dog owner may have their dog undergo certified training and require a follow up report by a certified dog behaviorist stating the dog is no longer a risk to bite. Successful completion of these requirements would allow for the vicious designation to be removed.


This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of final passing.

Bylaw No. 521-22 is hereby amended.
