BYLAW NO. 442-12

EMERGENCY SERVICES DISPATCHING BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF STIRLING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF LETHBRIDGE FOR THE PROVISION OF PROVIDING EMERGENCY SERVICES DISPATCHING SERVICES.

WHEREAS THE Village of Stirling may provide any service or thing that it provided in all or part of the municipality in another municipal authority with the agreement of the other municipal authority pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act* (R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26.1);

NOW THEREFORE by virtue of the power conferred upon it by the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of Village of Stirling, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1.1 This By-law shall be known and may be cited as the "Emergency Services Dispatching Bylaw" of the Village of Stirling.
- 2.1 The Council of the Village of Stirling hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer to execute the approved agreement with the City of Lethbridge for emergency services dispatching services.

This Bylaw comes into force on the day it is finally passed.
