VILLAGE OF STIRLING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA Bylaw No. 520-22 Election Act Ballot Printing Bylaw

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF STIRLING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF DIRECTING THE PROCESS OF LOCAL ELECTION BALLOT PRINTING.

WHEREAS, the provisions of the Local Elections Act, Revised Statues of Alberta 2000 provides for the printing of ballots in lots under section 43;

AND WHEREAS, the Village of Stirling Council wishes to have election ballots printed in lots;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Stirling, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Election ballots shall be printed in as many lots as there are candidates.
- 2. In the first lot the candidates name shall appear in alphabetical order. In the second lot the names shall appear in the same order, except that the first name in the first lot shall be placed last, and in each succeeding lot the candidate's name shall be in alphabetical order except the first name in the preceding lot shall be placed last
- The ballots, on election day, shall be arranged so that no two consecutive electors
 will receive ballot papers from the same lot such that each candidate's name shall
 appear first and in each other position substantially the same number of times on
 the ballots used.
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the date of passing of the third and final reading.
- 5. This Bylaw hereby repeals Bylaw 371-98, Revised Local Authority Election Bylaw.
