## VILLAGE OF STIRLING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

## **BYLAW NO. 556-25**

**BEING** a bylaw of the Village of Stirling in the Province of Alberta, to amend Bylaw No.549-24, being the municipal Land Use Bylaw.

AND WHEREAS the Village Council desires to designate the following land described as:

All of the Closed Lane in Block 33 Plan 752J

to "Residential (R)", as shown on the map in Schedule 'A' attached hereto.

**AND WHEREAS** the described land is an undeveloped Lane that has been closed and has not previously been assigned a land use designation.

**AND WHEREAS** the municipality must prepare a corresponding bylaw and provide for its consideration at a public hearing.

**THEREFORE** under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, the Council duly assembled does hereby enact the following:

- 1. That the land described as All of the Closed Lane in Block 33, Plan 752J, as shown on the attached Schedule 'A', is designated Residential (R).
- 2. That the Land Use Districts Map of the Village of Stirling Land Use Bylaw No. 549-24 be amended to reflect this designation.
- 3. Bylaw No. 549-24, being the Land Use Bylaw, is hereby amended and a consolidated version of the Land Use Bylaw reflecting the amendment is authorized to be prepared.
- 4. This bylaw comes into effect upon third and final reading hereof.

READ a first time this 7 day of May, 2025.

READ a second time this 18 day of June, 2025.

READ a third time and finally PASSED this 18 day of June, 2025.
