VILLAGE OF STIRLING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA Bylaw No. 557-25 Repealing Old Bylaws

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF STIRLING IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING NON-CURRENT AND OR OUTDATED BYLAWS, IN THE VILLAGE OF STIRLING

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act (Alberta, R.S.A 2000, Chapter M-26 sec 63.1 as amended or repealed and replaced from time to time, authorizes the Council of a municipality, by bylaw to,

- (a) Omit and provide for the repeal of a bylaw, or a provision of a bylaw that is inoperative, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective,
- (b) Omit, without providing for its repeal, a bylaw or a provision of a bylaw that is of a transitional nature or that refer only to a particular place, person or thing or that has no general application throughout the municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000, Chapter M-26 provides for the Village Council with the authority to deal with Village Bylaws:

AND WHEREAS the Village of Stirling Council passed Policy C03-25 Council Renumeration Policy, taking affect January 1, 2026 and Policy AR16-25 Travel and Expense Policy; thereby removing the need for Bylaw 452-14.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A 2000 M-26, as amended 2019, Village Council for the Village of Stirling, duly assembled, repeals the following bylaw;

1. Bylaw 452-14 is hereby repealed effective January 1, 2026.

This Bylaw shall become effective upon the third and final reading.
