Evaluations, Upcoming Events & Updates:

- Honoured Guests: Sandra reported
 - O Successful; ~ 221 attendees; ~ \$1620 donated at the door
 - o Decorations and activities/entertainment/recognitions were noted as excellent; food & service was great
 - o A good time was had by all; it was wonderful to see the joy and delight demonstrated by old friends reuniting
 - o The Village fully supports this event and will always do what's needed to ensure it happens
 - But our committee agreed that the:
 - Wards will keep rotating and hosting
 - The Lions will be the "accountants"
 - The Seniors are expected to donate sufficiently to pay for costs that exceed donations received at the door
 - o From the funds they receive from casinos and other fund raiser activities
 - Mike Amen suggested/moved, and all agreed that:
 - Whenever possible, the Events Committee will annually pay a portion (up to \$2,000) from any budget surplus it has at year end
- Settler Days
 - Karma shared and led a discussion on the extensive "big picture" plans developed by Aimee, Sandra & herself
 - It was agreed that we stick to the basics that are event standards expected and add only those that are manageable
 - "Fund raiser" opportunities will not be subsidized so must be priced to be self-sustaining
 - Food type offerings should not be so extensive as to detract from the traditional, expected, "Beef on a Bun" supper
 - Promotion should begin as early in June as possible
 - KISS principle emphasizing the event itself, highlighting in general, the main activities w/o going into too much detail
 - o Aletta will administer the electronic publicity and keep it updated
 - o Posters will be created consistent with the "Big Picture" approach
 - "New" areas in the Village were identified and discussed as better venues for:
 - Car show, crafts, spray activity, snack hosting
 - Soccer field, parking lot south of the community center, the community center itself
 - o Coordinated by Aimee, she, Karma and Sandra will continue to flesh out the plans, find and confirm people to take charge of the various activities
 - And find sponsors
- Alberta Days Grant has it been applied for and we should find out in June if our application was successful
