### Councillor Foss:

• Ridge Water Commission (RWC)

- Solar not feasible due to the environmental review (birds), not to be perused further.
- Contract for the Writing-on-Stone park up for tender (bit of a surprise to the commission staff). Hoping to continue with this as it assists in revenue and allows for additional staff for the commission and main plant.
- Oldman River Regional Services Commission (ORRSC)
  - GIS module to create work orders on the admin / public works just rolling out.
  - Talked about the recent public uproar about the 15 minute cities controversy.
  - Unsightly premises case law highly advised by courts that clear and adequate advisement to take action "aka" a court order, prior entering to clean the property when no action to resolve has taken by the owner.
  - New planner and grant funded intern coming onboard so some planner assignment changes will be happening over the next year. (not sure if we will see any change or not).
- Ridge Regional Public Safety Service Commission (RRPSSC)
  - \$25,000 in fine revenue so far this year due to new "community engagement vehicle". Beginning to lay ground-work for second community engagement vehicle in a few years.

  - Have made flower holders for cemetery for sale \$25 a piece.

  - Clean up May 13, 2023
