Planning for emergencies means planning for everyone in your household, including pets. Consider your pets' unique needs so you have the information, contacts, and supplies you need to care for them during an emergency.

Get started and #BePrepared with these pet preparedness steps: 



Make an [emergency contact list](#):

Include pet-friendly hotels, kennels and loved ones who could help you provide a safe place for your pet to stay in an emergency.



Complete a [pet profile card](#):

Create a profile for each of your pets with important information, including vaccination records, medications and tattoo, microchip or license number(s). Store digital and physical copies for easier access.



Build a [pet emergency kit](#):

Gather supplies like food, medications, and other supplies your pet(s) may need. If space in your home is limited, make a grab-and-go list instead.
