Draft Municipal Development Plan

The Village of Stirling has prepared a Draft Municipal Development Plan (MDP) and Council wants to hear from you!

The MDP is a long-range, general policy document intended to guide development toward the community's desired future. As the primary land use planning and community development guiding document, the MDP helps Council and municipal staff make decisions on planning and development matters.

In the Spring of 2021, the Village commenced the process of formulating the MDP. The process involved a review of existing land uses, identification of opportunities for community growth, and public consultation to identify goals and objectives.

An important part in developing this Draft MDP was to ensure that it reflected the vision and concerns expressed by the people who live in Stirling. A community-wide survey was the first stage of public consultation followed by student surveys for Grades 6, 9 and 12. The feedback we received through public consultation and discussions amongst Council provided the foundation for the policies contained in this Plan.

As the Village prepares to consider the Draft MDP, we invite you to review the draft document and let us know what you think!

A public hearing will be scheduled prior to adoption of the plan with notice to follow, which is anticipated to occur in Summer 2022.
